**Breeders are hereafter described as “the Breeder”**  
**New Owner/s are here after described as “the Purchaser”**

**The Purchaser agrees to the following:**

That owning a pet is a commitment for the life of the pet.

Under no circumstances will this kitten/cat be sold, leased, given away, or sold to a pet shop or similar facility unless consultation is sought and permission is granted from the Breeder.

This kitten/cat is purchased for purposes of being a pet.

If at any stage the kitten/cat is found to be neglected or mistreated, the Breeder has the right to take possession of the kitten/cat unconditionally.

If at any stage care of the kitten/cat is unable to continue, the Purchaser will return ownership of the kitten/cat to the Breeder unconditionally.

**The Breeder agrees to the following:**

The kitten/cat has had at least one vaccination, has been desexed and microchipped.

The kitten/cat is more than 10 weeks of age at the time of delivery (as per New Zealand Cat Fancy Inc Registration Rules).

New Zealand Cat Fancy Registration papers for the kitten/cat will be transferred to the ownership of the Purchaser as soon as possible after delivery.

To be available to provide information pertaining to the kitten/cat to the Purchaser as applicable at any stage throughout the kitten/cat's life.

**Health Guarantee**

To cover reasonable costs of Veterinary attention within two weeks of delivery of kitten/cat provided:

- Veterinary treatment is sought as soon as possible after symptoms are noticed (ie same day).
- The Breeder is informed of illness at the first opportunity (within 24 hours).
- The Breeder is informed of Veterinary treatment costs at the first opportunity (within 24 hours).
- Illness is certified by a Veterinarian as caused by hereditary defect or infectious illness by way of written certification.

To refund the purchase price of the kitten/cat or replace free of charge another kitten/cat if the said kitten/cat dies in either of the two circumstances:

- Within three weeks of delivery subject to a written Veterinary Pathologist's report giving cause of death as infectious disease.
- OR Within sixth months of delivery subject to a written Veterinary Pathologist's report giving cause of death as a hereditary defect.

Pre-delivery explanations and/or concessions made in writing may preclude the above Guarantee.
